1	<p>Storage of Non Hazardous Chemicals, Oils, Gases, Tyres, Rubber products, Tobacco, Alcohol, Perfumes, Aerosol Cans, Scrap/Waste, in a pre-built warehouse & Plot of land, will require prior approval from EHS</p> <p>Trading, Storage, handling of Hazardous Chemicals, Dangerous Goods, Radioactive material, /, Explosives (for construction use),</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Shall require prior approval from relevant authorities &EHS and the plot should be located in the JAFZA-Chemical Zone. 2. Shall not be stored in the Pre-built warehouse <p>For handling and storage of Hazardous Chemicals, Dangerous Goods, Radioactive material, /, Small Explosives etc. on the plot “Risk Assessment Study” (RA) and/or “Environment Impact Assessment Study” (EIA) shall be carried out by the client through EHS approved EIA & RA Consultants, if their activities fall under the criteria of RA & EIA.</p> <p>Trading and Storage of Arms & Ammunition, Animal and Animal By-Products are not Permitted for storage and handling and hence shall not be carried out</p> <p>The following goods are prohibited from entering the Free Zone:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Spoiled Goods b. Goods, which violate the laws protecting commercial, industrial, environmental intellectual and literary and artistic property rights. c. Boycotted goods or goods, which the Government may decide to boycott. d. Goods which bear writings, drawing, decorations, marks or forms conflicting with the beliefs, teaching and concepts of the revealed religions. e. Raw opium, prepared opium coca leaves, cannabis (Indian Hemp) and qat leaves.
2	<p>Any kind of Industrial, Service or Maintenance/Repair/Assembly activities will not be part of the Logistic License.</p> <p>For carrying out any special Industrial / Assembling / Service related activities the client shall approach JAFZA for a separate industrial/service license or approval.</p>
3	<p>Any kind of Promotional Packing and Repacking of the traded goods shall require prior approval from EHS.</p> <p><u>Printing, labeling and re-labeling on the product</u>, that would alter part or in full of the product’s information relating but not limited to, the expiration and production dates, name of manufacturer and country of origin, and ingredients list, is not permitted by JAFZA.</p>
4	<p>All PCFC, EHS, GWP (Good Warehousing Practice) and other relevant local, national and/or international rules, regulations and requirements on importation, handling, storage and distribution of the products should be complied with</p>
5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Prohibited Chemicals</u> as listed by “Ministry of Health” (MOH) should not be imported. • For import of <u>Controlled Chemicals</u> as listed by “Ministry of Health” (MOH) shall necessitate prior approvals from “Ministry of Health - UAE.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Explosive Restricted by “Ministry of Interior and National Security” shall not be dealt with. For import of Dangerous goods (chemicals) into Dubai, provisions of Dubai Municipality ETG-46 should be adhered.
6	<p>Approval from the following authority should be obtained if the products are to be Imported and Distributed in Dubai and the rest of the Emirates.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Ministry of Health -Medicines & Para pharmaceuticals, Medical Equipment, Medical Herbs Dubai Municipality-Clinic Section - Personal care, baby requisites, Perfumes, Cosmetics - Ministry of Environment & Waters - Agriculture, Fertilizers, Pesticide Products Grain Products &Animal & Birds Feed Dubai Municipality: Food Control Section, Health Food & All Food items – Dubai Municipality: Toys & Games – (for testing & certification) ESMA: Toys & Games (Conformity Certification) Ministry of Information: Publications and Media Dubai Police: Alcoholic Drinks
7	<p>For Food & Hygiene Related products- Records of Import and export and/or distribution of the products should be maintained, so that goods may be efficiently and effectively recalled from the market place when a product poses a health risk to the population or when serious contravention of the regulations has occurred. Records of consumer complaints and action taken should also be maintained, and all records should be kept for at least two years or according to the shelf life of the product.</p>
8	<p>Any kind of Food & Beverages, Pharmaceutical, Medical & Health-related Products, Agricultural Products, Personal Care Items, Beauty Products, Perfumes & Cosmetics, Soap & Hair Care requisites and Toys can be permitted under this logistic license but shall be subject to review and approval by EHS-Food & Health department & other applicable relevant authorities’</p>
9	<p>Records of Import and export and/or distribution of the products should be maintained, so that goods may be efficiently and effectively recalled from the market place when a product poses a health risk to the population or when serious contravention of the regulations has occurred. Records of consumer complaints and action taken should also be maintained, and all records should be kept for at least two years or according to the shelf life of the product</p>
10	<p>The broad Rules and Regulations governing the EHS & Fire Dept. requirements are as included in (but not limited to) the following, should be adhered during the design, <u>construction & operational</u> stage of the facility:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Building & General Civil Work Construction Regulation Environmental Control Rules & Requirement & Environmental Guidelines. Health & Safety and Fire Protection Regulations & Standard FZ Rules & Regulations, DM / HACCP Guidelines
11	<p>General storage configurations and installation of Racking etc. within the facility shall require EHS approvals and minimum 1 meter clearance/distance from warehouse walls/structure to the Racking, storage goods should be maintained.</p>

12	Client will have to adhere to the Guidelines of “National Fire Protection Association” (NFPA), which are adopted by the TRAKHEES-EHS Authority, for Fire Detection & Protection, during the operational stage. • http://www.ehss.ae/forms/fireprotectionfirepreventionfirecontrolregulations2010edition.pdf
13	Facilities shall be required to provide provisions of specific requirements relating to storage the food/health/pharmaceutical products and temperature controlled storage wherever applicable.
14	Adequate area for parking/loading of vehicles/trailers should be provided within the premises and no outside (of premises) parking of such vehicles/equipment will be permitted.
15	Providing accommodation and Cooking shall not be permitted in the open yard. Storage of traded goods in the open yard shall require approval from JAFZA and EHS.
16	As per EHS Rules, use of containers for storage purpose and use of portacabins in the clients premises is not be permitted during the operational stage
